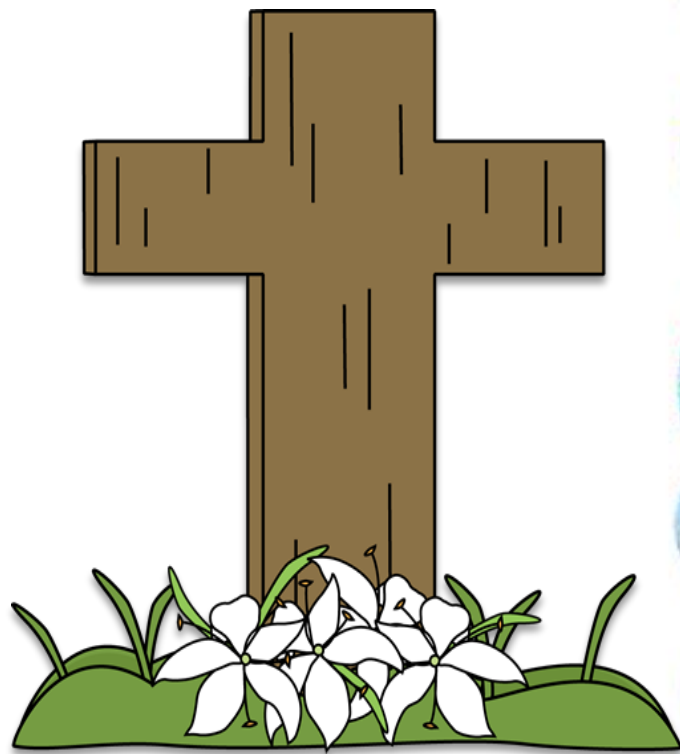
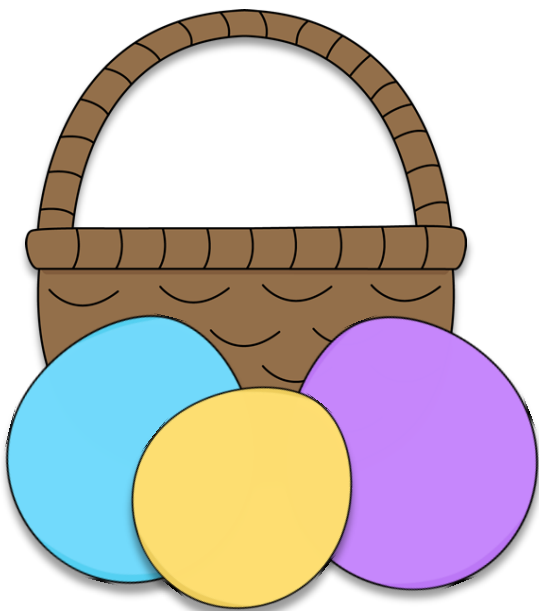

The following activities are designed to be used in conjunction with Resurrection Eggs that can be purchased or made separately.

There are 2 different sets that I have found to be the most popular. I have included activity pages for each set.

Cut and Paste Activity (Page 5 or 30)

Option 1: You can have children complete this activity while you are telling the Resurrection Eggs story. Children cut out the pictures (symbols) from the bottom of the page. As you open the eggs and tell the story, they glue the symbol on the correct number egg.

Option 2: This activity can be completed after you have already told the story using the Resurrection Eggs. It can be used to review the order of events. Children cut out the pictures (symbols) and put them in order (match them to the correct number egg).

Around the Room Activity - Resurrection Egg Hunt (Pages 6-9 or 31-34)

Cut out the 12 large numbered eggs with symbols from pages 6-8 or pages 31-33. Hang them around the room in random order.

Give each child a copy of the Resurrection Egg Hunt worksheet (page 9 or 34). Students search around the room for each numbered egg from their sheet and circle the correct symbol for each egg.

My Resurrection Eggs Student-Made Book (Pages 10-18 or 35-43 or 54-86)

Students cut apart each of the book pages as well as the symbols. They can color the title page and print their name on the "Created by" page.

Students read each page, trace the symbol word, and glue the appropriate symbol in the square.

This activity can also be completed during or after the telling of the story using the Resurrection Eggs. It provides students with a nice keepsake and reminder of the Easter story.

•• If you would like to print the book on both sides of the paper (copy back to front), use the double sided copies of the book found on pages 54 - 86. ••

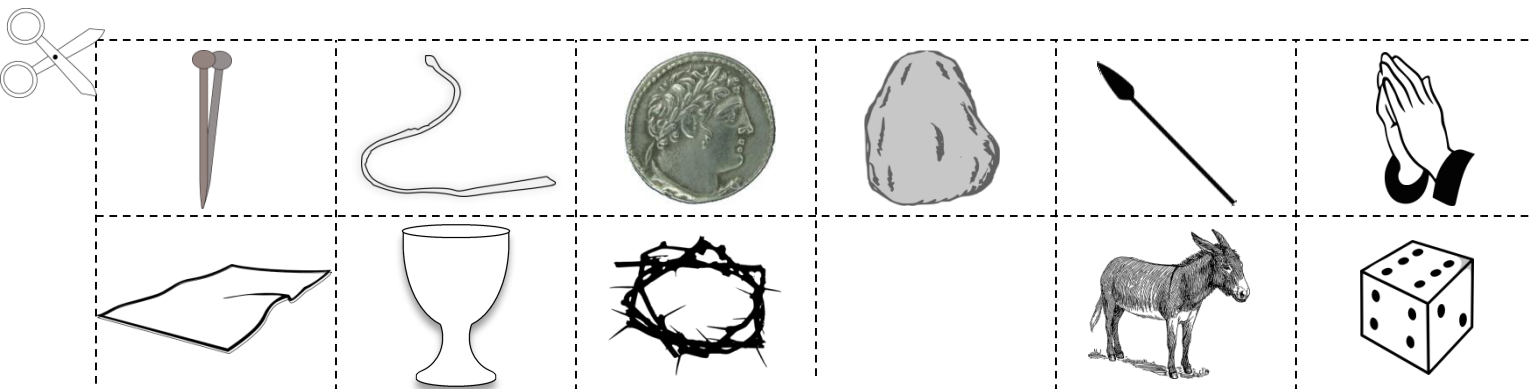
